

ARTHUR TILDESLEY SCHOLARSHIP

AGRICULTURE RELATED

The late Arthur Tildesley was a prosperous Lone Rock farmer. He made provision in his will for the establishment of this scholarship. This scholarship will be awarded annually to a deserving applicant who is enrolled in a program to prepare for a career in agriculture, agri-business, or an occupation directly related to or of service to the agricultural industry.

Amount

One @ \$1000

Criteria

The applicant must be a graduate of LCHS. Former students of LCHS who have completed their high school education without having enrolled in another high school program will be considered "graduates" of LCHS and will be considered eligible for the scholarship.

At the time of the award the applicant must be registered in a post-secondary institution. The program must be preparatory for or lead directly to a career that is related to agriculture. Such programs include but are not restricted to diploma or degree programs in agriculture. Other suitable programs include agriculture, veterinary medicine, agricultural mechanics, animal husbandry, and agricultural technology.

Students enrolled in general arts and science programs who are considering transferring, in subsequent years; to agriculture related programs are eligible.

There is no restriction as to the number of years an eligible applicant may apply. Applicants need not have attended LCHS in the preceding academic year.
