BEA FISHER SCHOLARSHIP

The Bea Fisher scholarships are donated by the Lloydminster Parkland Residence Society to commemorate her many years of service to the organization.

It is intended to provide assistance to students pursuing a career that includes a demonstrated interest and aptitude for **working with persons with disabilities.** This will include students enrolled in programs of study leading to future employment as teachers, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, speech-language pathologist or rehabilitation assistants. Applicant has been a full time student at LCHS and is a member of current or prior years graduating class.

Amount

Two @ \$1000

Criteria

The awarding of these scholarships shall be based on the following criteria:

a) Genuine interest in helping persons with disabilities as demonstrated by volunteerism or parttime employment.

b) Ability to relate positively with persons with disabilities.

c) Stated career intentions related to working with persons with disabilities.

At the time of the award, the applicant is enrolled in programs of study leading to careers as teachers, physiotherapists, occupational therapists and speech-language pathologists, relative to applicants enrolled in rehabilitation assistant programs.

If potential recipients are judged to be equally deserving of the scholarships, preference shall be shown to applicants who have received less scholarship monies.

Note: Applicants enrolled in a Faculty or College of Education must have completed or be currently enrolled in at least one course in exceptionality or special education.

Former LCHS students may apply in each of the four years following graduation from LCHS providing they meet all other eligibility criteria.
