Amount

One @ \$2000.00

Criteria

An LCHS graduate who at the time of application is registered for and/or has been enrolled in a recognized post-secondary institution in a teacher education program of studies with an English major or a career with English as a major component.

At the time of the award the applicant chosen to receive the scholarship must be enrolled in the program of studies described in the letter of application.

Former graduates shall submit a transcript of courses and grades reflecting post-secondary attendance.

Applicants will include a resume with their application.
